On a piece of paper, answer the following questions and be ready to share.

- 1. Who took the photo and if known, where and when?
- 2. Why did you select this photo? What about this photo attracted you?
- 3. What emotion does the photo communicate, and how?
- 4. Does your experience of the photo change once you read its caption or find out about it? (If the photo has no caption, write "no caption".)
