On a piece of paper, answer the following questions and be ready to share.

1. Who took the photo and if known, where and when?
2. Why did you select this photo? What about this photo attracted you?
3. What emotion does the photo communicate, and how?
4. Does your experience of the photo change once you read its caption or find out about it? (If the photo has no caption, write "no caption".)
