

Street Photography Investigation

Go to flieschool.com/photographers. Click on the Category tab at the top and choose Street at the bottom of the list, then click the Filter button to filter the results. Browse through the photographers that catch your eye, and for those that you like, find more of their work by following the resource links or searching on your own. You could also do a search for famous street photographers.

Create some sort of document to record your investigation.

For five different photographers:

1. Look through at least twenty or more of their photos - more than I have on my website for most. BE VERY CAREFUL OF GOOGLE IMAGE SEARCH RESULTS: many of the images will be by other people. You have to go to the page and read to make sure the image is actually by the photographer you're looking for.
2. Choose one of your favorite photos by the photographer and copy it into your document. If you cannot drag the photo to the desktop or into your document, type Command-Shift-4 and drag a box around the photo to take a screenshot of it. The screenshot will be saved to the desktop as Screenshot.blahblahblahsomethingorother - you should be able to drag that into your document.
3. Below the photo, give the photographer's name and any info you can find about the photo - date, title, and any caption.
4. Tell something you like about the subject matter.
5. Tell something you like about how the subject was photographed.
6. Do not choose the same photos as your friends sitting next to you. Do not copy other's work or thoughts.
